Dear Parent / Guardian

As you are aware the Mock Leaving Examinations will begin on Thursday 3rd Feb.

A copy of the timetable can be downloaded from the latest news section of the school website. The students also have a hard copy of the timetable.

Students are not required to be in school when they do not have an exam and should use this time for productive revision at home. If however a student has both a morning and afternoon exam they will **be allowed to leave** the school between both exams. A study room will be available for students who wish to remain in school.

Those students who are leaving school at the end of an exam are advised to leave the school as soon as the exam finishes as classes are in progress for other year groups. Students should use this time to continue preparation at home. We ask that students do not congregate in the community or around the shops in the breaks between exams. Should there be issues with this we will review the decision and make arrangements for the students to remain in school for study between exams.

A student is required to remain in the examination centre for the duration of the exam.

All students are required to be present at their exam centre 10 minutes before the exam is due to start. It is important that students familiarise themselves with the start times of each exam

Can I take this opportunity to remind students that the school uniform rule applies during the mock examination weeks.

I would like to remind parents that the mock fees can be paid in person or through the Easypayment tab on the school website. Payment should be made by Friday 4th Feb.
