Dear Parent/Guardian and our Class of 2022,

Please find attached your invitation to our Graduation ceremony for the Class of 2022. We cannot believe how the years have passed, as your son/daughter begin their preparations for the next stage of their life journey.

We are delighted to be able to once again celebrate this important event in person.

The Graduation ceremony takes place on Thursday 26th May 2022 at 6.30pm. We ask that everyone is seated by 6.15pm to ensure the prompt start of the ceremony. We respectfully ask that students dress appropriately for the occasion as it is the final formal school occasion gathered as a year group. As we have a large group of graduates, we would must ask families to restrict their numbers attending to maximum of 3. More than this, we cannot guarantee seating at the event.

In preparation for the ceremony, the students will attend a rehearsal in on Wednesday 25th during the school day. **All graduating students must attend this rehearsal in full uniform.** Gowns will be fitted during the rehearsal. A reminder that there is a rental charge of €30 for the gown, €10 of which is refunded once the gown is returned. Any student who decides not to wear a gown will graduate in school uniform. Traditionally, the graduating students present a small gift back to the school as a token of appreciation. Tutors are collecting €1 and we would encourage all students to make this contribution.

Preparations for the state examinations will continue following Wednesday's celebration. Teachers will be available for block lesson should the students wish to attend. **We expect all students attending block classes wear our school uniform with pride and strictly follow our code of behaviour in all areas of school life. This also applies whilst sitting their State Exams.**

Please be aware that should any celebrations be planned among the year group for the night of the ceremony, students need to be mindful that Covid 19 is still in our community and should limit interactions in the run up to their exams.

We look forward to celebrating this special evening with you all as we reach the end of these extraordinary academic years at Le Chéile Secondary School and we bid farewell to our Leaving Certificate Class of 2022, who are about to set out on the next awaiting adventure.
